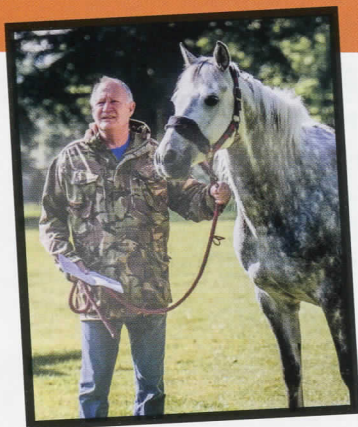
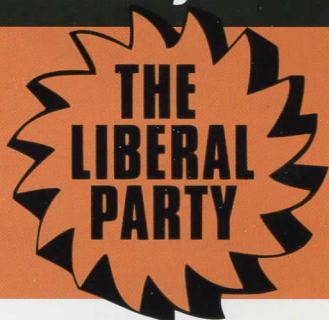

Our Priorities will be...

- Prevent over development of so called 'affordable housing' to ensure social housing needs are met instead.
- A bank in every town
- A green curriculum to be introduced in all schools
- An environment tax on goods transported over a certain distance by road
- A Cornish Assembly to replace Cornwall Council
